

Car Eligibility for Cars Not Listed in the 1981 GCR

Only those production cars listed on pages 79-80, and GT-1 (includes B Production) through GT-4 cars listed on pages 124-6 of the 1981 GCR are eligible for competition without additional documentation. For cars not listed, the Eligibility Committee may require FIA homologation papers or other eligibility documentation. All production, sedan or GT category cars that were eligible cars in Pre-1981 SCCA GCR's are eligible to run under the 1981 GCR's if they are prepared to the 1981 specifications. The committee may also request documentation for any modification that appears to exceed the scope of these rules or any modification that may not appear to be period correct. It is the responsibility of the owner/driver to provide documentary evidence to support inclusion of unlisted makes, models and their specifications; and similarly for modifications or additions to the car. Such evidence can include:

- 1981 model year or earlier SCCA recognition forms (e.g., GCR, PCS, GTCS) for the make and model
- 1981 model year or earlier factory specification sheets, option sheets or catalogs
- Homologation papers for the make and model of cars included within FIA Groups 1, 2 or 3, through model year 1981
- Other documentation through model year 1981, such as photos and articles from print media sources, may also be considered by the Eligibility Committee
