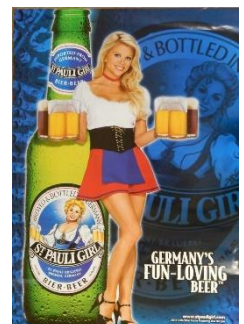
To celebrate FVs, we established a special area of the paddock for all FVs and called it "VeeVille". Check out VeeVille and see all the FVs racing in one spot!
